Disinfecting Tips

Establish a disinfecting routine before, during and after each practice or game to protect against infections and kill odors.

Step 1

Remove any dirt or debris from equipment. Take apart equipment, pads and undo straps, etc. Inspect equipment to ensure in good working order with no damage.

Step 2

Thoroughly spray Clear Gear on all parts of the equipment (inside and out) ensuring that all surfaces touched or shared are sprayed.

- **Helmets and gloves:** Spray liberally inside the helmet (3-5 sprays) with special attention to the forehead area and chin straps. Spray the crown of the helmet and in the crevices to prohibit the growth of mold, mildew, and odor-causing bacteria.
- **Cleats:** Apply 3-4 sprays inside cleats, making sure to spray the tongue and walls of the boot.
- **Pads and braces:** Spray the inside of the pads that come in contact with skin.
- **Equipment bags:** periodically empty the bag of all equipment and contents, and spray liberally inside the bag.

Step 3

After treating with Clear Gear, hang equipment in a well-ventilated area and allow to fully air dry. Avoid storing gear in damp, musty environments, which increases the growth of bacteria, mold, mildew, and odor. Once fully dry, store in a closet, locker, equipment bag.

Step 4

Remove uniform or practice clothing from athlete. Spray clothing and let remain wet for 10 minutes. Then machine wash. Once dried the clothing is ready to wear.
